to him and asked about amployment in a "news room tv

to him and asked about employment in a "news room type job," telling Bagdikian she did not like working in the Personnel Department and was not interested in that kind of employment. Bagdikian wrote to her and advised there was nothing available.

Sometime during the period she was staying with following her return to California, she received a call from a Los Angeles representative of "The Washington Post" asking for interview which she subsequently granted. A reporter, whose name she could not recall, told her he was doing a story on the Rand Corporation. He wanted to know "what Rand was really like" and was interested in talking with Rand employees who had been in Vietnam. During the interview he asked her questions about her work at Rand, what it was like to work "in a think tank," and her opinion on the situation in Vietnam. She recalled one specific question, "Do you think Rand was responsible for what went wrong in Vietnam?" The reporter showed no interest in the Pentagon Papers and asked no questions about them.

said the reporter seemed uninformed and his questions were naive. She told him he should be asking his questions at the Rand Corporation and he told her he had spent the whole day there talking to people. He mentioned some former Rand employees he had talked with and included Tony Russo's name among these.

next contact with Bagdikian followed her return to Washington, D.C., in November, 1971. She called Bagdikian and told him she was again interested in working for the newspaper. He said there was nothing available, but he would call her back. She has had no further contact with him.

recalled when she spoke with Bagdikian in November, he said he was no longer the national news editor of the newspaper and was now an ombudsman with a couple of people helping him. Bagdikian did not elaborate.

assumed that as an ombudsman Bagdikian would be handling complaints and matters of that sort for the newspaper.

Regarding information previously furnished on November 17, 1971, concerning her association with Anthony Russo,
